

Only organizations officially representing one of Florida's 30 historic lighthouses are eligible for Lighthouse Membership. The Board of Directors bestows this membership on a qualified lighthouse group (non-profit, lessee or owner) paying annual membership dues. Each member lighthouse designates a Voting Delegate. The Board reserves the power to review and approve new Lighthouse Membership applications.

LIGHTHOUSE MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

★ Board Representation

- Each member lighthouse is entitled to 1 vote on the Board of Directors
- If the designated lighthouse's Voting Delegate can not attend a board meeting, they may designate an Alternative Voting Delegate to vote for that lighthouse by notifying the board secretary in writing or by email before the board meeting

★ Membership Meeting Representation

- Each member lighthouse group can send a total of 3 people at the membership rate to FLA membership meetings.
- The Voting Delegate is solely responsible for registering their lighthouse's 3 attendees for each meeting. All registration must be done at FLA's website using the Lighthouse Delegates profile.
- Each of the member lighthouse's 3 registered attendees is entitled to 1 vote at FLA membership meeting (total 3 votes).
